

# Fiscal Year 2011 Coral Reef Information System (CoRIS) Accomplishments

# **Highlights**

**Content and Technical Improvements** – CoRIS began development of a new data discovery tool using the ESRI Geoportal technology. The new search tool will provide enhanced ability for temporal and spatial searches. The tool will also allow users to save searches as customized GeoRSS feeds and provide a way to restrict search results to those data that are downloadable vs. offline. We expect to launch the search tool during 2012.

In addition to the Geoportal project we also restructured, reformatted, and updated the "Featured Documents" section of the website and added a search feature to the CoRIS Glossary of Terminology application.

**New Metadata and Data** – Added 549 metadata records to CoRIS and made 2,571 record updates. At the conclusion of FY11 CoRIS had a total of 4,576 metadata records that provide users access to approximately 41,726 coral data products.

**New Publications** – Entered 315 publications into the CoRIS virtual library, bringing the total number of publications in CoRIS to 3,128.

**Outreach** – CoRIS provided outreach material at the NOAA booth for two ESRI Conferences and the U.S. Coral Reef Task Force meeting, and briefed Ms. Sissy Iona of the Hellenic National Oceanographic Data Centre in Attica and Dr. Libby Jewett of the NOAA Ocean Acidification Program about the Coral Reef Information System and larger CRCP data management activities.


**Coral Program Support** – Provided monthly, quarterly, and annual reports to the CRCP office on coral projects that contributed metadata, data, and publications to CoRIS. CoRIS staff continued to send "overdue product letters" to CRCP-funded project managers and worked with Line Office representatives for updates, submittal and posting of NOAA project related documents.

Collaborations – Served as a member of the CRCP Data Management Working Group, CRCP Project Proposal Database Review Team, Deep Sea Coral Coordination Call, and other CRCP coordination groups, NESDIS Information Resource Management Team Metadata Meeting, NODC IT Systems Meeting, NODC Web Team Meeting, NODC Archive Management Working Group, FGDC Metadata Working Group, and the NOAA Environmental Data Management Committee

**Staff Technical Development** – CoRIS staff attended the NOAA Environmental Data Management Conference, NOS Summer Web Workshop, and multiple ISO metadata workshops.

In FY 2011, staff successfully added a total of 315 publications into the CoRIS virtual library.

#### **Outreach Activities**

- CoRIS staff attended the U.S. Coral Reef Task Force meeting in Washington D.C. on February 24, 2011 and provided booth materials to the Fall 2011 meeting.
- The CoRIS team briefed Ms. Sissy Iona from the Hellenic National Oceanographic Data Centre in Attica, Greece about the CoRIS project and the role of NODC within the Coral Reef Conservation Program.
- The CoRIS team briefed Dr. Libby Jewett about the CoRIS project and CRCP data management activities as part of a larger discussion about establishing data management practices for NOAA's Ocean Acidification Program.
- CoRIS provided material for the slide-show in the NOAA booth and a fact sheet about the project for distribution at the 2011 ESRI Federal User Conference and the ESRI International User Conference.

# Coral Reef Conservation Program Support

- CoRIS began to implement new product tracking procedures due to recent requirements outlined in the CRCP Matrix Budget Accountability Policy.
- Staff continued to send CRCP-funded Project Managers "overdue product letters" and/or requests for updates on outstanding products for fiscal years 2002-2011.
- CoRIS prepared an annual report and three quarterly status reports detailing web use trends and highlighting project accomplishments and CRCP Project Manager submissions related to metadata, data, publications, and information products.

 288 items (new metadata, publications, etc.) were contributed by CoRIS to eight issues of NOAA's Coral Reef News newsletter during FY 2011.

## **Collaborations**

- Based on requirements for the CRED online Data Access tool we modified the CoRIS search code to allow search terms to be passed as part of the URL string to enable CoRIS metadata documents to be returned as part of the user interface in the CRED Data Access tool.
- CoRIS continues to participate as a member of the following Data Management Working Group, Deep Sea Coral Working Group, CRCP Project Proposal Database Review Team, and Deep Sea Coral Coordination Call.
- Staff attends the monthly CRCP Program Manager Check-in meeting and Coral Collaboration calls.
- CoRIS participates in meetings and working groups that fall outside of the CRCP umbrella, , NESDIS Information Resource Management Team Metadata Meeting, NODC IT Systems Meeting, FGDC Metadata Working Group, NODC Archive Management Working Group, NODC Web Team and miscellaneous NODC Staff and Division Meetings.

# Web Site Content and Technical Improvements

#### General

- CoRIS made updates to the website to increase the visibility of linkages between the CoRIS, CRCP, and USCRTF websites. The CRCP graphic identifier was added to all pages in the CoRIS website to brand the CoRIS search tool as a product of NOAA's Coral Reef Conservation Program. In addition, links to the CRCP and USCRTF websites are now included on every page of the CoRIS website.
- The CRCP General Program Description page (http://coris.noaa.gov/activities/) on the CoRIS website was updated to reflect changes to the program as outlined in the 2010- 2015 Goals and Objectives.
- A Retired Pages section was added to the CoRIS website
   (<a href="http://coris.noaa.gov/retired/">http://coris.noaa.gov/retired/</a>). This new section will provide access to pages which have been removed from the primary website for historical reference.

#### **Data & Publications**

- In FY11 CoRIS received permission from the NOAA Library to include the full abstract for all entries within the CoRIS virtual library including journal articles. CoRIS staff updated all journal articles previously entered into the library to include both the abstract and link to the full text, where available. These additions will provide users with a better understanding of the work CRCP is doing.
- Overall navigation of the CoRIS website was improved to allow users to access and search CoRIS metadata, data and publications catalog from multiple entry points. Staff also restructured the Featured Publications section of the website to

better accentuate key documents produced by CRCP partners. A Featured Archive was added to host key documents that were featured in previous years.

#### Regional Portal

The Regional Portal provides users with a wide range of region specific data and information from a single page. CoRIS continued to provide region specific updates to the fourteen (14) regions on the website.

  was updated to include additional terms and has been expanded with a more user
  friendly means of navigation within the file.
