CoRIS Project Highlights

- An important component of NOAA's Coral Program efforts to protect coral reef ecosystems from land based sources of pollution (LBSP) has been the development of watershed management plans (WMPs) and conservation action plans. We have recently added a page to the CoRIS website which provides consolidated access to these plans and the corresponding implemented recommendations by jurisdiction: http://www.coris.noaa.gov/activities/projects/watershed/
- The CoRIS Map Search was upgraded to a newer version of Google Maps software due to changes in the IT security requirements. The map code was also updated to support the full searchability of the ISO 19115-2 metadata format as some offices have begun to support metadata in the new format.
- Two project pages were added to capture the source materials used to generate watershed management plans in the U.S. Virgin Islands



CoRIS Product Highlights

Metadata – The 5,105 metadata records in CoRIS provide managers, researchers, and the public access to 49,016 coral data products via the CoRIS Web site portal. As identified in Table 4, CoRIS continues to acquire metadata. Between January and March 2014, staff added 33 new metadata records and updated 3,276 records.

Publications – CoRIS received and cataloged 118 coral publications in the CoRIS virtual library or NOAA Library from January to March 2014. Types of products on the CoRIS website include NOAA technical memoranda and formal reports, workshop reports, conference proceedings and abstracts, unpublished scientific reports, citations of published journal articles, websites, educational brochures, field guides, and video imagery. The CoRIS Web site currently provides access to 3,920 coral publications and online resources, which are referenced in the NOAA Library or CoRIS virtual library database.

CoRIS serves as a portal to NOAA coral data and information. The project is gathering data and publications from CRCP-funded PIs and other NOAA coral sources and making this information

discoverable on the CoRIS Web site for use by the public. The following ten tables summarize and provide details about the metadata, data, and publications available through CoRIS.
